## **Sheltering the Homeless: A Corporal Work of Mercy**

Many of our patients come from out of town and out of state. Mercy Hospital provided rooms through McAuley Inn. In the beginning, this was a house furnished by the Zonta Society on Forbes Avenue with shuttle service in the middle of the night, if needed, by the Mercy security van.

As the need became greater and the wear and tear of the house became evident, rooms were made available on the top floor of the Southeast wing of the hospital. This made it easier for families to see their loved ones and to have a place of respite as needed. The need increased even more, and additional rooms were made available in the Mercy Health Center (MHC) apartments.

These rooms are constantly in use and in need of upgrading. Donations were received by the UPMC Mercy Foundation in memorial for a family member. To meet the estimated cost, funding was requested from the MHSN Alumni Association. The Board discussed the request as well as available funds at the March MHSN Alumni Board meeting.

Throughout the years your donations have been used for scholarships to assist Alumni in furthering their education. The last major donation was toward the renovation of the MHSN Auditorium in 1995. The MHSN is well funded for equipment and scholarships. The MHSN Alumni money needed a valued purpose. The Board considered the request and made a gift of \$15,000 to supplement upgrading the apartments.

With the opening of the Vision and Rehabilitation Center, which is being built at this time, there is an even greater need for housing anticipated. These rooms will be an asset to our patients and families who will need an overnight stay in the city after surgery. Your generosity will help many people. Thank you in advance for your consideration.




